The most-traded January iron ore on Chinas Dalian Commodity Exchange (DCE) ended daytime trade 0.61% higher at 986.5 yuan (\$136.80) a metric ton. The benchmark December iron ore on the Singapore Exchange climbed 0.88% to\$134.35 a ton, following a 1.15% drop in the previous session.
